Join fellow Earlhamites, parents, and friends of the College for the chance to hear the latest news from campus and meet with Julia May. We will gather at 6:00 p.m. for a wonderful Irish dinner at Kennedy's Steak and Seafood.

Julia May is a native of Charlottesville, Virginia and holds a Ph.D. in art history from Virginia Commonwealth University. She is in her fifth year at Earlham. Her specialties include Australian Aboriginal art and Native American art. In 2007 Julia and Earlham Biology professor Brent Smith led a May Term program to Australia that focused on three perspectives critical to understanding the rich and complex nature of Australia's indigenous people: their art, culture and ecology. Most recently Julia led the Studies in Cross-Culture Education (SICE) program in Morioka, Japan.

Julia's talk will focus on Earlham's first-class collection of art from the farthest reaches of the globe to local and regional artistic traditions that form part of Indiana's rich cultural heritage. The presentation will highlight works from indigenous artists of Africa, Australia, the South Pacific and Asia, present those by well-known artists such as Pablo Picasso, Henri Matisse and James McNeill Whistler, and brings the discussion closer to home with the works of famed Indiana painters John Elwood Bundy, George Baker and T.C. Steele. The Earlham Art Collection, comprised of almost 4,000 works, is truly, in the words of the College's motto, an "Engagement with a Changing World," and has something for everyone!
