

Health Policy

Purpose

Given the wide range of views regarding horse health and vaccinations, the Earlham College Stables has set forth the Health Policy to standardize the requirements for horses on the premises. This policy is intended to ensure the safety and well being of all the horses.

Policy

A. Vaccinations

1. Horses arriving in the fall are required to have had the same spring vaccinations as all the Earlham College Stables horses. If they are arriving in the winter (after fall shots have been done) they must have all the same vaccinations the Earlham College Stables horses received.
2. All horses stabled at the Earlham College Stables must receive specific shots in the fall and spring.
 - a. The required vaccinations may vary on a yearly basis, depending on the advice of Earlham's veterinarian.
 - b. Boarders may request that their horse receives different vaccinations, and they may do so if approved by Earlham's veterinarian.

B. Requirements for incoming horses

1. All incoming horses must have up-to-date vaccinations, health certificates, and recent coggins in accordance with the requirements of the State of Indiana Department of Agriculture.
2. These health records must be given to the Barn Manager or Horse Care Manager at least **5 days prior** to the arrival of the horse unless specifically arranged with Barn Staff. No horse will be allowed on the property without these documents.
