

FAHE Annual Conference at Woodbrooke June 19-22, 2008

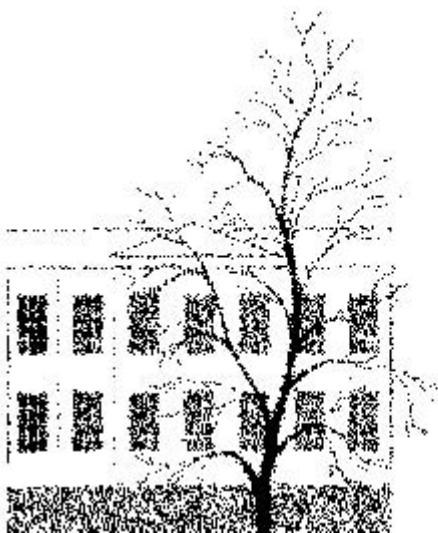
Where Faith and Practice Meet
